Day 1: Erfurt – Nebra

After the official welcoming we start from our tour hotel in Erfurt to this cycling tour. Soon we reach Weimar, the city of Germanys famous poets Goethe and Schiller. We follow the rivers IIm & Saale to Naumburg with its famous cathedral. Here we meet the Unstrut cycling path, that will bring us to the wine city of Freyburg and finally to our destination in Nebra.



Day 2: Nebra – Mühlhausen

Our route follows the river Unstrut mainly flat. Not far from Nebra we pass nearby the findspot of the famous Nebra sky disc and we visit the ancient Memleben monastery. At Heldrungen we can see the Kyffhäuser mountains in a distance. With a quite challenging detour the mountain and Emporer Wilhelm monument can be visited. After cycling through Porta Thuringia, we leave the river Unstrut and at the latest at Wasserthaleben we observe a more and more hilly topography. We are heading towards Mühlhausen with its medieval old town and city walls, that is close to the geographical center of Germany

Day 3: Mühlhausen – Eisenach

Today we follow the Unstrut for a while to Dingelstädt, then turn onto the Kanonenbahn cycle path. At Treffurt we follow the most beautiful part of the Werra river via Creuzburt to Hörschel. From here it is not far to our destination in Eisenach, where you can detour to the UNESCO world heritage Wartburg castle.

Day 4: Eisenach – Erfurt

Today we cycle half of the day along the northern foothills of the Thuringian Forest. Track 2 can expect some challenging climbs in this low mountain landscape. Later we turn to the north and reach again Erfurt.



Route characteristics

This tour has flat and hilly sections. In particular track 2 will follow several challenging routes e.g. in the Thuringian Forest.

If possible the routes follow minor roads and cycling paths. Unavoidable sections on major roads are reduced to the absolute minimum. In any case it is recommended to use cycling paths along the streets where available.
