

GBI @ Rad am Ring - Through the green hell



After pausing a couple of years the GBI will join the 'Green hell' in 2023 again. Be part of the iconic 24 hours cycling event at the Nürburgring and join one of the various GBI teams.

The race track offers over 500 m of altitude difference and an overall length of 22 km with 72 bends and it also features the bike arena at the Grand Prix paddock. The track leads right through this arena, where around 3,000 competitors put up their tents.
